The Chair called up the following measures separately:

1. [H.R. 8476 \(Rep. Fine\)](#) A bill to require each local educational agency and institution of higher education that receives Federal financial assistance to treat discrimination motivated by antisemitism as vigorously as such agency or institution treats other forms of discrimination prohibited by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and for other purposes.
 - i. Rep. Fine (R-FL) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8476, designated [MU8476_ANS_01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 8476 as amended was requested. H.R. 8476 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 20 yeas and 12 nays.

2. **H.R. 4795 (Rep. Foxx)** A bill to amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to prohibit an institution that participates in a nonexpressive commercial boycott of Israel from being eligible for certain funds under that Act, to require an institution that participates in certain programs under that Act to certify that students are not unreasonably obstructed from participating in academic programs in Israel, and for other purposes.
 - i. Rep. Foxx (R-NC) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4795, designated [4795ANS 01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 4795 as amended was requested. H.R. 4795 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 24 yeas and 9 nays.
3. **H.R. 9203 (Rep. Stefanik)** A bill to increase the transparency of colleges and universities in carrying out their civil rights responsibilities, and for other purposes.
 - i. Rep. Fine (R-FL) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 9203, designated [MU9203ANS 01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 9203, designated [SCOTT_AMD 01](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 18 nays.
 - b. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 9203, designated [SCOTT_AMD 02](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 18 nays.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 9203 as amended was requested. H.R. 9203 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 18 yeas and 15 nays.
4. **H.R. 2555 (Rep. Houchin)** A bill to amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to provide for certain freedom of association protections, and for other purposes.
 - i. Rep. Harris (R-NC) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 2555, designated [MU2555ANS 01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 2555, designated [SCOTT_AMD 01](#). The amendment

failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 18 nays.

- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 2555 as amended was requested. H.R. 2555 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 18 yeas and 15 nays.

5. **H.R. 5505 (Rep. Walberg)** A bill to amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to ensure campus access at public institutions of higher education for religious groups.

- i. Rep. Walberg (R-MI) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 5505, designated [MU5505ANS_01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
- a. Rep. McBath (D-GA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 5505, designated [MCBATH_AMD_01](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 18 nays.
- b. Rep. Bonamici (D-OR) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 5505, designated [BONAMICI_AMD_03](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 5505 as amended was requested. H.R. 5505 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 18 yeas and 15 nays.

6. **H.R. 2332 (Rep. Mann)** A bill to authorize the use of the Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal history record information for administration of certain licenses.

- i. Rep. Owens (R-UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 2332, designated [MU2332ANS_01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 2332 as amended was requested. H.R. 2332 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 33 yeas and 0 nays.

7. **H.R. 4122 (Rep. Allen)** A bill to permit nurse practitioners and physician assistants to furnish necessary services, appliances, and supplies to individuals receiving medical benefits for illnesses.

- i. Rep. Allen (R-GA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4122, designated [4122_ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.

- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 4122 as amended was requested. H.R. 4122 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 32 yeas and 0 nays.
8. **H.R. 8822 (Rep. Mackenzie)** A bill to amend the Federal Employees' Compensation Act to permit the Secretary of Labor to obtain certain information relating to earnings and employment.
- i. Rep. Mackenzie (R-PA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8822, designated [8822 ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 8822 as amended was requested. H.R. 8822 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 32 yeas and 0 nays.
9. **H.R. 8823 (Rep. Mackenzie)** A bill to amend the Federal Employees' Compensation Act to allow the Secretary of Labor to suspend payments to medical providers who have been convicted of fraud.
- i. Rep. Mackenzie (R-PA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8823, designated [8823 ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 8823 as amended was requested. H.R. 8823 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 33 yeas and 0 nays.
10. **H.R. 9381 (Rep. Walberg)** A bill to direct the Bureau of Labor Statistics to report on the usage of artificial intelligence in the workplace.
- i. Rep. Walberg (R-MI) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 9381, designated [9381 ANS 01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 9381 as amended was requested. H.R. 9381 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 19 yeas and 14 nays.
11. **H.R. 9228 (Rep. Onder)** A bill to amend the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 to ensure plan fiduciaries have access to de-identified information relating to health claims, and for other purposes.

- i. Rep. Onder (R-MO) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 9228, designated [ONDER_030](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - a. Rep. Takano (D-CA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 9228, designated [TAKANO_HD_ACCESS_01_AMD](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 18 nays.
