

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 9610
OFFERED BY Mr. Mannion**

Add at the end the following:

1 SEC. 12. PROHIBITION ON TRANSFER OF ACTIVITIES RE-
2 LATED TO INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 9 and
4 11, or any other provision of law, no functions related to
5 the provision of services to, or education of, children or
6 adults with disabilities (including under the Individuals
7 with Disabilities Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1400 et seq.)
8 and the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 701 et
9 seq.)), including any such functions described in section
10 2, may be eliminated or consolidated, or transferred to an-
11 other Federal agency or official thereof.

12 (b) OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES.—No officer or em-
13 ployee of the Department of Education who carries out
14 a function described in subsection (a) may be reassigned
15 or detailed to another Federal agency for purposes of car-
16 rying out such function at such agency.

17 (c) CONTRACTS.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
18 sion of law, the Secretary of Education may not contract
19 with any entity outside of the Department of Education

1 for the administration or enforcement of functions de-
2 scribed in subsection (a) unless the Secretary is expressly
3 authorized to do so under the Individuals with Disabilities
4 Education Act (20 U.S.C. 1400 et seq.) or the Rehabilita-
5 tion Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 701 et seq.).
