The Chair called up the following measures separately:

1. **H.R. 8781 (Rep. Arrington)** A bill to clarify that for purposes of Federal nondiscrimination requirements applicable to education programs or activities receiving Federal financial assistance, discrimination prohibited under title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 is based on the biological reality of sex.
 - i. Rep. Miller (R-IL) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8781, designated [H8781ANS_001](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
 - ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 8781 as amended was requested. H.R. 8781 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 18 yeas and 15 nays.
2. **H.R. 4986 (Rep. Miller)** A bill to amend the General Education Provisions Act to ensure that a student is not required to submit to a survey, analysis, or evaluation that reveals personal information about such student or their family without prior written consent.

- i. Rep. Miller (R-IL) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4986, designated [4986ANS_01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 4986 as amended was requested. H.R. 4986 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 18 yeas and 15 nays.

3. H.R. 8747 (Rep. Fine) A bill to amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to include certain curriculum expenses as permissible uses of funds, and for other purposes.

- i. Rep. Owens (R-UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8747, designated [8747ANS_01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
- a. Rep. Scott (D-VA) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8747, designated [SCOTT 8747AMD_02](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a [recorded vote](#) was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a recorded vote of 15 yeas and 18 nays.

4. H.R. 8183 (Rep. Owens) A bill to amend the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act to provide for the establishment of talent marketplaces.

- i. Rep. Owens (R-UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8183, designated [HR8183_ANS_2](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 8183 as amended was requested. H.R. 8183 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 33 yeas and 0 nays.

5. H.R. 9723 (Rep. Grothman) A bill to establish the President's Council on Sports, Fitness, and Nutrition, and for other purposes.

- i. Rep. Mackenzie (R-PA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 9723, designated [HR9723ANS_01](#).

6. H.R. 8660 (Rep. Mackenzie) A bill to amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to protect worker access to employer equity; and for other purposes.

- i. Rep. Mackenzie (R-PA) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8660, designated [8660ANS 01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 8660 as amended was requested. H.R. 8660 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 18 yeas and 15 nays.

7. H.R. 8347 (Rep. Owens) A bill to classify qualified locum tenens professionals and advanced care practitioners as independent contractors for the purposes of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 and the National Labor Relations Act.

- i. Rep. Owens (R-UT) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8347, designated [8347ANS 01](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 8347 as amended was requested. H.R. 8347 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 18 yeas and 15 nays.

8. H.R. 6213 (Rep. Messmer) A bill to prohibit the Secretary of Labor from finalizing, implementing, or enforcing a proposed standard with respect to heat injury and illness prevention.

- i. Rep. Messmer (R-IN) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6213, designated [HEAT SAFETY_ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
- a. Rep. Adams (D-NC) offered an amendment to the amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 6213, designated [ADAMS_ADAMNC_612](#). The amendment failed by a voice vote and a recorded vote was subsequently requested. The amendment failed by a [recorded vote](#) of 15 yeas and 18 nays.
- ii. A recorded vote on the motion to report H.R. 6213 as amended was requested. H.R. 6213 was ordered favorably reported to the House as amended, by a [recorded vote](#) of 18 yeas and 15 nays.

9. H.R. 5267 (Rep. Hern) A bill to preserve the franchise business model.

- i. Rep. Wilson (R-SC) offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 8775, designated [HR8775_ANS](#).
 - The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
