

Kyle Koeppel Mann is a Senior Staff Attorney and Coordinating Attorney for Pro Bono Clinics in the Immigrant Protection Unit (IPU) at the New York Legal Assistance Group (NYLAG). She primarily represents crime victims and victims of intimate partner crime on applications to obtain lawful immigration status, such as U-Visas and Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Self-Petitions, and on their adjustment of status applications and citizenship applications.

Kyle received her B.A. from New York University, and her J.D. from Benjamin N. Cardozo School of Law, where she concentrated on Criminal Law and Procedure and Constitutional Law and Rights. She is admitted to practice in New York.
