Deena B. Margolies is a Litigation Staff Attorney at the Louis D. Brandeis Center for Human Rights Under Law, where she represents and advises Jewish and Israeli students, faculty, healthcare professionals, and other employees facing anti-Semitic harassment and discrimination. Her work includes litigation, federal civil-rights complaints, agency submissions, investigations, and negotiated resolutions involving schools, universities, workplaces, healthcare settings, and labor-related matters.
