## BARBARA C. LEE, RN, PhD

Barbara Lee is a Senior Research Scientist at Marshfield Clinic Research Institute in Marshfield, Wisconsin. She has directed the NIOSH-funded National Children's Center for Rural and Agricultural Health and Safety since its establishment in 1997, now the longest-standing and largest such center in the U.S. She has dedicated the majority of her career advocating for the protection of children who are exposed to agricultural hazards. Dr. Lee led the development of the first National Action Plan for Protecting Children in Agriculture and facilitated subsequent updates to that plan which guides federal funding and private sector donations. She is a past co-chair of the National Occupational Research Agenda (NORA) Agricultural Sector Council, past president of the International Society for Agricultural Safety and Health and in 2007 she co-founded the Agricultural Safety and Health Council of America, an agribusiness-led non-government organization based in Washington D.C. for which she continues to serve on its Board of Directors.
