

Rosemary Jenks is Cofounder and Policy Director of the Immigration Accountability Project (IAP). IAP's mission is to educate voters on the immigration actions, and inactions, of their elected representatives so they can make informed decisions and participate fully in civil debates regarding how immigration policy serves the national interest.

Rosemary has worked on immigration issues since 1990. She served as Director of Government Relations for NumbersUSA from 2001 until 2023. Before that, she was Director of Policy Analysis at the Center for Immigration Studies, a Washington, D.C.-based immigration think tank.

Rosemary has testified before both the House and the Senate immigration subcommittees on several occasions, before the bipartisan Jordan Commission on Immigration Reform, and before numerous state legislative bodies.
