Chairman Walberg and Ranking Member Scott,

As the President of TGB Promotions, LLC, an internationally known boxing promotional company, I write in strong support for H.R. 4624, the "Muhammad Ali American Boxing Revival Act" (MAABRA). For well over 30 years, I have been intimately involved in all aspects of boxing.

To be frank, the great American sport of boxing has been floundering and is in need of help. In my opinion, MAABRA is the solution. It will position boxing to flourish by adding competition and accountability to this great sport. As HBO, Showtime, and ESPN stopped broadcasting boxing, the questions are why, and what can be done?

MAABRA's fundamental innovation is the express allowance of an alternative system in which a "Unified Boxing Organization" ("UBO") is permitted to compete with the current sanctioning organization model. Congress, when it enacted the Muhammad Ali Boxing Reform Act twenty-five years ago, recognized that the lack of a centralized industry organization was the core problem hampering boxing. In fact, Congress found that the lack of such an organization "has led to repeated occurrences of disreputable and coercive business practices in the boxing industry, to the detriment of professional boxers nationwide."

MAABRA fixes that problem. Given the legislation's framework, a UBO will invest in and promote fighters' careers and produce matches that fans want to see. Boxing events are both unpredictable and sporadic, which make it extremely difficult for

fans to follow the sport. Bringing predictability and consistency to event promotions and broadcasts will grow the sport in a way that is similar to the growth in mixed martial arts over the last twenty years. Further, I believe this legislation will open a pathway to a new generation of boxers, as well as fans, that does not exist today. To me, that prospect is incredibly exciting.

I should also add that the health and safety components of this bill will benefit boxing immensely. These fundamental reforms, such as medical testing, third-party antidoping programs, and health insurance requirements, will raise the bar for the entire sport.

In my experience, MAABRA is the best thing that has come along in years. I commend you for considering this groundbreaking legislation, and I truly hope it is enacted by Congress and the President.
