

Biographical Sketch

Jeff Buczkiewicz is President and CEO of the Mason Contractors Association of America (MCAA), the national trade association representing the \$41 billion masonry industry and approximately 4 million employees nationwide. He has led MCAA since 2007 and has worked in the association industry, representing construction related organizations for more than three decades.

Under his leadership, MCAA developed the GEORGE Technology Stack, the masonry industry's first purpose-built suite of artificial intelligence, virtual reality, and LIDAR tools designed to improve jobsite safety, workforce training, and productivity. Mr. Buczkiewicz currently participates in the White House AI in Education Task Force on behalf of the construction trades.

Mr. Buczkiewicz serves as Chair of the Masonry Technical Committee for SkillsUSA and has served as a masonry liaison to the NCCER Workforce Development and Safety Committee. He developed MCAA's national Youth Education and Outreach Program and created the Generational Knowledge Project, which leverages AI to preserve the expertise of senior industry leaders as on-demand digital mentors for the next generation. He also serves on the Executive Committee of the Construction Industry Safety Coalition and is President and CEO of The Masonry Foundation.

Mr. Buczkiewicz is the 2026 recipient of the C. DeWitt Brown Leadman Award, the Mason Contractors Association of America's highest individual honor for industry leadership.
