Strada Education Foundation ("Strada") is not a recipient of WIOA funds. However, one of Strada's wholly owned charitable subsidiaries has received a Department of Labor Advancing Delta Talent Grant (\$1.4M) and was also a subrecipient of a Department of Labor Digital Workforce Apprenticeship Partnership Grant (\$240K). In addition, some of Strada's charitable subsidiaries have engaged in workforce-related projects that were likely funded, indirectly, by WIOA funds. For example, Strada subsidiaries have provided services (both directly and indirectly through intermediaries) to regional workforce boards. All such projects occurred at the subsidiary level and represent a negligible portion (i.e., less than ~1%) of Strada's overall aggregated revenue and activities.

Please list any federal grants or contracts (including subgrants or subcontracts) related to the hearing's subject matter that you, the organization(s) you represent, or entities for which you serve as a fiduciary have received in the past 36 months from the date of the hearing. Include the source and amount of each grant or contract.

Strada Education Foundation has not sought or received any federal grants or contracts. However, over the last three years, one of Strada's wholly-owned charitable subsidiaries received three direct federal grants for workforce-related projects ((i) Department of Agriculture SNAP Employment and Training National Partnership Grant (\$1.4M); (ii) Department of Labor Advancing Delta Talent Grant (\$1.4M); and (iii) Department of Education Connected Pathways Program Grant (\$4.9M)) and was a subrecipient of \$240,000 under the Department of Labor Digital Workforce Apprenticeship Partnership Grant. All such grants were received at the subsidiary level and represent a minimal portion (i.e., less than ~5%) of Strada's overall aggregated revenue and activities. Strada's subsidiaries also provide educational and workforce-related services to other organizations, including some organizations that receive federal funding.
