

Zalman Rothschild is Assistant Professor of Law and Horn Family Distinguished Research Scholar in Law and Religion at the Benjamin N. Cardozo School of Law. Previously, he was a Bigelow Fellow at the University of Chicago Law School. He holds a JD, *magna cum laude*, from Harvard Law School and a PhD in Hebrew & Judaic Studies from New York University.
