

Katherine Van Dyck is a Senior Legal Fellow at the American Economic Liberties Project and a leading national expert on private equity's influence on youth sports. In December 2025, she testified before this Subcommittee on private equity's takeover of youth sports leagues and facilities, and her work on the issue has been featured by USA Today, The Athletic, and More Perfect Union. Ms. Van Dyck has spent more than two decades championing robust antitrust enforcement and consumer rights; representing consumers, employees, and small businesses fighting abusive corporate practices in courts across the country; and demonstrating how concentrated economic power raises prices, depresses wages, and shutteres small businesses. During the Biden Administration, Ms. Van Dyck served as an Attorney-Advisor in the Federal Trade Commission's Office of Policy Planning, where she expanded and ran the agency's amicus program. She is also the founder of KVD Strategies PLLC, a Senior Fellow at UC Berkeley Law's Civil Justice Research Initiative, and a graduate of Texas Christian University and the Texas Tech University School of Law.
