## 3/6/14 Foreign Affairs Committee Markup Summary

The Chair called up H. Res. 499 for consideration by the Committee.

<u>H. Res. 499 (Royce)</u>, "Condemning the violation of Ukrainian sovereignty, independence, and territorial integrity by military forces of the Russian Federation."

Poe 69, as amended, was agreed to by voice vote.
