## 5/09/14 Foreign Affairs Committee Markup Summary

The Chair obtained unanimous consent to consider the following items (previously provided to Members) *en bloc*:

- H.R. 4587 (Ros-Lehtinen), "To impose targeted sanctions on individuals responsible for carrying out or ordering human rights abuses against the citizens of Venezuela, and for other purposes."
  - a. Salmon 46, amending H.R. 4587;
- 2. <u>H.R. 4573 (Smith NJ)</u>, "To protect children from exploitation, especially sex trafficking in tourism, by providing advance notice of intended travel by registered child-sex offenders outside the United States to the government of the country of destination, requesting foreign governments to notify the United States when a known child-sex offender is seeking to enter the United States, and for other purposes"
  - a. Smith 53, an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H.R. 4573; and
- 3. <u>H. Res. 573</u>, "Condemning the abduction of female students by armed militants from the terrorist group known as Boko Haram in northeastern provinces of the Federal Republic of Nigeria"
  - a. Royce 105, amending H. Res. 573.

The *en bloc* items were agreed to by voice vote, and the measures, as amended, were ordered favorably reported to the House by unanimous consent.
