

JACQUELINE ISAAC, ESQ.

Attorney Jacqueline Isaac, aged 29, is the Vice President of *Roads of Success*, a non-profit organization dedicated to empower women and minorities in the Middle East. Her missions have been featured on FOX, NBC, ABC, *The Blaze* and other international media. She is a frequent guest on *Roads of Success'* Arabic language television programs reaching millions. Her grass roots work has given her opportunities to meet His Holiness Pope Francis, UN Secretary General Bin Ki Moon, His Holiness Pope Tawadros II, the Grand Imam of Al-Azhar, and other world leaders.

Isaac has partnered with her mother, Yvette Isaac, President of *Roads of Success*, to launch numerous refugee aid missions, helping internally displaced persons, and families of victims in Iraq, Jordan and Egypt. In 2015, Isaac brought a team of medical and trauma experts to begin to restore hope among girls who were captured, sold, raped, tortured by ISIS and escaped, to boost the morale of internally displaced children and families, to distribute supplies on the infamous Sinjar mountain and to visit the frontlines with the Peshmerga-the Kurdish military forces. Isaac has been invited to prepare recommendations to the Iraqi-Kurdistan parliament as they revisit the Kurdish Regional Government's draft Constitution, expected to be voted on by referendum in the near future.

As an American of Egyptian descent, Isaac lived in Egypt during her teenage years. She started movements to decrease discrimination of religious minorities, barbaric practices against women such as female genital mutilation, child marriage and participated in the UNDP Middle East HIV/AIDs program in Cairo.

Isaac took part in drafting Egypt's 2014 Constitution, she was given the opportunity to participate with delegates of the Constituent Assembly. Isaac also founded the "God Created All" movement, promoting peace, interreligious unity and a participation in civic dialogue among community and religious leaders in Egypt.

Isaac partnered with the Jordan Hashemite Charity Organization, under the leadership of His Royal Highness Prince Mired Raad Zeid Al-Hussein, to undergo a relief campaign for Syrian refugees living in Jordan and provided motivational messages on the importance of social responsibility to help prevent gender violence and promote hope within the camps.

Isaac's inspiration is to bring peace, hope, education, equal rights and religious freedom to women, children and refugees in the Middle East.
