Leon Wieseltier is the Isaiah Berlin Senior Fellow in Culture and Policy at the Brookings Institution, and Senior Editor and Critic at The Atlantic. From 1983 to 2014 he was the Literary Editor of The New Republic. Mr. Wieseltier is the author of a number of books, including *Nuclear War, Nuclear Peace and Kaddish*, which was translated into many languages. His essays on political, religious, and cultural subjects, on foreign policy and national security, have been widely published. Mr. Wieseltier has taught at Harvard, the University of Chicago, Johns Hopkins University, and elsewhere. Mr. Wieseltier was born in 1952 and was educated at Columbia University; Balliol College, Oxford University; and Harvard University, where he was a member of the Society of Fellows. In 2013 Mr. Wieseltier was awarded the prestigious Dan David Prize.
