7	(2) other forms of transnational organized
8	crime, including arms trafficking, human smuggling,
9	money laundering, and illicit financing, are drivers
10	of irregular migration;
11	(3) narcotics trafficking is fueled by govern-
12	ments that fail to curb the illicit drug trade by ade-
13	quately regulating the legal trade of non-fentanyl
14	opioids and precursor chemicals used to produce
15	fentanyl, fentanyl analogs, and other synthetic
16	drugs;
17	(4) further, governments that do not cooperate
18	sufficiently on financial investigations and prosecu-
19	tions, withhold information with respect to money

1	laundering crimes, or are determined to facilitate il-
2	licit activities, particularly by transnational orga-
3	nized criminal organizations, should be held account-
4	able;
5	(5) as noted in the International Narcotics Con-
6	trol Strategy Report 2020, China "has not cooper-
7	ated sufficiently on financial investigations and does
8	not provide adequate responses to requests for finan-
9	cial investigation information";
10	(6) the United States should apply economic
11	and other targeted financial sanctions with respect
12	to individuals engaged in financial crimes and money
13	laundering that fosters narcotics trafficking in the
14	countries of Latin America and the Caribbean; and
15	(7) The United States should look to policies
16	to hold accountable countries that fail to sufficiently
17	investigate financial crimes and money laundering
18	that foster narcotics trafficking in the countries of
19	Latin America and the Caribbean.
