## A BILL

- To require the Secretary of State to submit to Congress a report on the People's Republic of China's support to the Russian Federation with respect to its unprovoked invasion of and full-scale war against Ukraine, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Assessing Xi's Inter-
- 5 ference and Subversion Act" or "AXIS Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. FINDINGS AND SENSE OF CONGRESS.

2 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:

3 (1) On February 4, 2022, weeks ahead of the
4 Russian Federation's invasion of Ukraine, Russia
5 and the People's Republic of China released a joint
6 statement following a meeting between Vladimir
7 Putin and Xi Jinping, which outlined a strategic
8 partnership with "no limits" and no "forbidden"
9 areas for cooperation.

10 (2) On February 24, 2022, Russia invaded
11 Ukraine in an unprovoked and unjustified act of
12 war.

(3) China abstained from voting on the February 25, 2022, United Nations Security Council
resolution and the March 2, 2022, United Nations
General Assembly resolution condemning Russia's
invasion of Ukraine.

(4) As of April 1, 2022, China has not publicly
condemned Russia's unprovoked and illegal invasion
of Ukraine.

(5) In his call with Xi Jinping on March 18,
2022, President Joe Biden communicated that there
would be "implications and consequences if China
provides material support to Russia as it conducts
brutal attacks against Ukrainian cities and civilians".

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(b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con2 gress that—

3 of (1)the People's Republic China's 4 disinformation efforts relating to the Russian Fed-5 eration's war against Ukraine make it culpable in 6 whitewashing Russia's war crimes, which include the 7 indiscriminate killing of countless Ukrainian men, 8 women, and children; and

9 (2) if China is found to be materially sup-10 porting Russia in its war against Ukraine, there 11 should be swift and stringent consequences for 12 China.

13 SEC. 3. REPORT.

14 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the 15 date of the enactment of this Act and every 90 days thereafter, the Secretary of State, in consultation with the Sec-16 retary of Commerce as appropriate, shall submit to the 17 appropriate congressional committees a report on whether 18 and how the People's Republic of China, including the 19 20 Government of the People's Republic of China, the Chi-21 nese Communist Party, any Chinese state-owned enter-22 prise, and any other Chinese entity, has provided support 23 to the Russian Federation with respect to its unprovoked 24 invasion of and full-scale war against Ukraine.

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(b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—The report re quired by subsection (a) shall include a discussion of the
 People's Republic of China support to the Russian Federa tion with respect to—

5 (1) helping the Government of Russia or Rus6 sian entities evade or circumvent United States
7 sanctions or multilateral sanctions and export con8 trols;

9 (2) deliberately inhibiting onsite United States
10 Government export control end-use checks, including
11 interviews and investigations, in China;

(3) providing Russia with any technology, including semiconductors classified as EAR99, that
supports Russian intelligence or military capabilities;

(4) establishing economic or financial arrangements that will have the effect of alleviating the impact of United States sanctions or multilateral sanctions;

19 (5) furthering Russia's disinformation and20 propaganda efforts;

(6) coordinating to hinder the response of multilateral organizations, including the United Nations,
to provide assistance to the people or Government of
Ukraine, to condemn Russia's war, to hold Russia

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1 accountable for the invasion and its prosecution of 2 the war, or to hold those complicit accountable; and 3 (7)providing any material, technical, or 4 logistical support, including to Russian military or 5 intelligence agencies and state-owned or state-linked 6 enterprises. 7 (c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a) 8 shall be submitted in unclassified form and published on 9 the Department of State's publicly available website. 10 (d) SUNSET.—The requirement to submit the report 11 required by subsection (a) shall terminate on the earlier 12 of— 13 (1) the date on which the Secretary of State de-14 termines the conflict in Ukraine has ended; or 15 (2) the date that is 2 years after the date of the 16 enactment of this Act. 17 (e) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congres-18 sional committees" means-19 20 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the 21 House of Representatives; and 22 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and 23 the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs of the Senate. 24
