Chad Wolf is the former Acting Secretary of the Department of Homeland Security under President Trump. In this position he oversaw an annual budget of approximately \$47 billion, managed over 240,000 employees in 22 operating components and agencies to include the fifth branch of the Armed Services – the U.S. Coast Guard.

Wolf is a nationally recognized expert in counterterrorism, law enforcement, transportation security, border security, immigration, emergency management, and critical infrastructure security.
