- 2. <u>H.R. 7256</u>, To require a full review of the bilateral relationship between the United States and South Africa. (James) (ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, 36Y 13N)
  - James Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute (adopted, voice vote)
  - Perry Amendment #444 to the Amendment in the Nature of Substitute (not adopted, voice vote)
- 3. <u>H.R. 3334</u>, To provide for the imposition of sanctions on members of the National Communist Party Congress of the People's Republic of China, and for other purposes. (McClain) (ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, 28Y 22N)
  - Barr Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute (adopted, voice vote)
- 4. <u>H.R. 5245</u>, To amend the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956 to require certain congressional notification prior to entering into, renewing, or extending a science and technology agreement with the People's Republic of China, and for other purposes.
