 - <u>Castro Amendment #102</u> (previously circulated as Sherman #102)(adopted, voice vote)
- 2. <u>H.R. 8315</u>, To amend the Export Control Reform Act of 2018 to prevent foreign adversaries from exploiting United States artificial intelligence and other enabling technologies, and for other purposes. (McCaul) (ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, 43Y-3N)
 - McCaul Amendment in the Nature of Substitute (adopted, voice vote)
- 3. <u>H.Res. 616</u>, Expressing support for the people of Afghanistan, condemning the Taliban's assault on human rights and the specific targeting of women, girls, and members of religious and ethnic minorities, and expressing support for any Afghans who assisted in the United States mission in Afghanistan. (Crow) (ordered favorably reported to the House, as amended, 46Y-0N)
