## On page 2, after the second full paragraph, insert a paragraph that reads:

"On September 9, 2024, Ranking Member Gregory Meeks transmitted a minority staff memorandum on the Committee's investigation in the 118<sup>th</sup> Congress into the U.S. withdrawal from Afghanistan. As the minority memorandum outlines, the investigation found, among other facts, that 1) the Trump Administration set a time-bound, full withdrawal into motion without regard for facts on the ground and failed to plan for executing it, 2) the Biden Administration kickstarted a robust process to review and prepare for completing the U.S. withdrawal already underway, and 3) the collapse of the Afghan Government precipitously changed the situation in Kabul and prompted a dynamic and unprecedented U.S. Government response that protected Americans, our allies, and our interests.
