## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5244 OFFERED BY MR. MEEKS OF NEW YORK

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1	SEC SPECIAL ENVOY FOR BURMA.
2	(a) Establishment of the Office.—The Sec-
3	retary shall establish within the Department of State ar
4	Office for the Special Envoy for Burma. Upon established
5	ment, the Office shall assume the primary responsibility
6	to lead United States policy and diplomatic efforts with
7	respect to Burma.
8	(b) HEAD OF THE OFFICE.—The head of the Office
9	shall be the Special Envoy for Burma, who shall be ap-
10	pointed by the President, by and with the advice and con-
11	sent of the Senate, and who shall report to the Assistant
12	Secretary for Special Diplomatic Missions.
13	(c) Limitation on Appointments.—The Specia
14	Envoy may not be a dual-hatted official with other respon-
15	sibilities within the Department of State or the executive
16	branch.
17	(d) RANK AND STATUS OF AMBASSADOR.—The Spe-
18	cial Envoy shall have the rank and status of ambassador
19	(e) Responsibilities of the Special Envoy.—

20 The Special Envoy shall be responsible for—

1	(1) coordinating policy development and execu-
2	tion related to Burma across all bureaus in the De-
3	partment and coordinating with interagency part-
4	ners;
5	(2) developing a comprehensive strategy that
6	utilizes the full range of United States diplomatic
7	capabilities to promote the restoration of peace and
8	a civilian-led democratic government in Burma;
9	(3) engaging stakeholders, including the Na-
10	tional Unity Government, democracy advocates, and
11	non governmental organizations, to promote dia-
12	logue, address issues related to atrocity crimes, pro-
13	vide humanitarian assistance, and combat
14	transnational crime, including trafficking in persons,
15	scam centers, and the illicit trafficking of narcotics
16	and weapons;
17	(4) advocating for the release of all political
18	prisoners in Burma and respect for human rights;
19	(5) coordinate an international effort with
20	United States allies and partners, including in multi-
21	lateral organizations, to isolate Burma military dip-
22	lomatically and impose and enforce sanctions and an
23	arms embargo against it;
24	(6) support protection, humanitarian assistance,
25	and accountability efforts for Rohingva and other

- with the appropriate congressional committees on

- 5 (f) TERMINATION.—The Office and the position of
