trafficking to the Assistant Secretary for International

(d) Prioritization and Consultation.—In car-
rying out the responsibilities listed in this section, includ-
ing the administration of relevant rewards programs, the
Assistant Secretary should—
(1) give priority to combatting the narcotics
trafficking and other criminal activities of
transnational criminal organizations designated as
such by Executive Order 13581 (76 Fed. Reg.
44757; relating to blocking property of transnational

criminal organizations), as amended, and in par-
