## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5300 OFFERED BY MR. AMO OF RHODE ISLAND

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1	SEC RESIDUAL SUPPLIES OF USAID.
2	(a) Procedures Required.—Not later than 60
3	days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
4	retary and the Administrator of the United States Agency
5	for International Development shall establish procedures
6	on the disposition of residual inventory of unused supplies
7	or commodities upon the termination or completion of a
8	project or program. Such procedures shall prioritize ensur-
9	ing that such supplies or commodities are not diverted,
10	destroyed, or otherwise expire without use.
11	(b) Publication.—The Secretary and the Adminis-
12	trator of the United States Agency for International De-
13	velopment shall publish the procedures established pursu-
14	ant to subsection (a) on a publicly available website of the
15	Department and Agency.
16	(c) COMMODITY DEFINED.—For purposes of this sec-
17	tion, the term "commodity" means a perishable or non-
18	perishable commodity or product (including medicine, vac-
19	cines, medical devices, food, and food commodities) that
20	is procured, managed, controlled, or held in warehouses,

- 1 ships, shipping containers, or any other storage facility,
- 2 by the United States Government or by a foreign assist-
- 3 ance implementing partner of the United States Govern-
- 4 ment for the purpose of providing foreign assistance.
