## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5300 OFFERED BY MR. AMO OF RHODE ISLAND

Amend section 601 to read as follows:

1	SEC. 601. AUTHORIZATION OF EFFORTS TO PREVENT AND
2	TREAT MALNUTRITION GLOBALLY.
3	The Administrator of USAID, in coordination with
4	the heads of other relevant Federal departments and agen-
5	cies, shall support efforts to prevent and treat malnutri-
6	tion globally, including by—
7	(1) targeting resources and nutrition interven-
8	tions to support the most vulnerable populations
9	susceptible to severe malnutrition, including children
10	under the age of 5 and pregnant and lactating
11	women;
12	(2) increasing coverage of the most cost-effec-
13	tive and proven malnutrition prevention and treat-
14	ment interventions, including:
15	(A) prenatal nutrient supplements,
16	(B) breastfeeding support,
17	(C) vitamin A supplementation,
18	(D) specialized nutritious food products for
19	the treatment of acute malnutrition, and

1	(E) other evidence-based interventions, as
2	appropriate;
3	(3) advancing evidence-based programs and
4	interventions carried out using data-driven ap-
5	proaches, best practices, and targeted to country-
6	specific contexts and needs;
7	(4) supporting partner governments to develop
8	policies to prevent and treat malnutrition;
9	(5) leveraging investments to strengthen health
10	systems, including to support community health
11	workers to advance improved nutrition outcomes
12	and
13	(6) ensuring rigorous monitoring and evaluation
14	of such efforts.
