

## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5300 OFFERED BY MR. BERA OF CALIFORNIA

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1	SEC SAFEGUARDING UNITED STATES EDUCATIONAL
2	AND CULTURAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMS.
13	(a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
4	gress that—
5	(1) Congress recognizes the critical role of
6	international exchange and study abroad programs
7	in advancing United States national security inter-
8	ests, strengthening diplomatic ties, and fostering
9	global leadership skills among emerging leaders, par-
10	ticularly in regions vital to United States strategic
11	interests; The supplemental and almif ) and the Time
12	(2) educational and cultural exchange programs
13	are critical soft power tools for building influence
14	with the next generation of leaders in partner na-
15	tions;
16	(3) the People's Republic of China is actively
17	deploying such programs to expand its influence;
18	and someon final transfer of the state of th
19	(4) the United States must expand and
20	strengthen its own exchange programs to maintain

1	and advance united States strategic interests glob-
2	ally.
3	(E) FUNDING PROHIBITION.—No funds authorized to
4	be appropriated by this Act may be used to reduce funding
5	for educational and cultural exchange programs adminis-
6	tered by the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs.
7	(c) Reporting Requirement.—
8	(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
9	after the date of the enactment of this Act, and an-
10	nually thereafter for a period of five years, the Sec-
11	retary of State shall submit to the appropriate con-
12	gressional committees a report that—
13	(A) lists, disaggregated by country, the
14	number of individuals participating in edu-
15	cational and cultural exchange programs spon-
16	sored or funded by the People's Republic of
17	China in the previous year;
18	(B) lists, disaggregated by country, the
19	number of individuals participating in edu-
20	cational and cultural exchange programs spon-
21	sored or funded by the United States in the
22	previous year, including—
23	(i) the International Visitor Leader-
24	ship Program;
25	(ii) the Fulbright Program:

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1	(iii) the Young African Leaders Initia-
2	tive, including the Mandela Washington
3	Fellowship;
4	(iv) the Young Southeast Asian Lead-
5	ers Initiative;
6	(v) the Young South Asian Leaders
7	Initiative;
8	(vi) the Young Pacific Leaders; and
9	(vii) the Young Leaders in the Amer-
10	icas Initiative;
11	(B) provides an assessment of trends of
12	participation in the programs described in sub-
13	paragraphs (A) and (B) and analyzes the impli-
14	cations of such trends for United States diplo-
15	matic and strategic interests; and
16	(C) analyzes the impact of such programs
17	on the diplomatic standing and strategic influ-
18	ence of the United States and the People's Re-
19	public of China in each respective country.
20	(2) FORM.—The report required under para-
21	graph (1) shall be submitted in an unclassified form,
22	but may include a classified annex.
