

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5300**OFFERED BY MR. FINE OF FLORIDA**

At the appropriate place in the bill, insert the following:

1 **SEC. __. ANTISEMITISM IN EUROPE.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—It is the sense of Congress that—

3 (1) the Assistant Secretary for European and
4 Eurasian Affairs, in consultation with other relevant
5 heads of the Department, should assess the per-
6 sistent and growing threat of antisemitism and acts
7 of international terrorism in Europe as a matter of
8 importance to the foreign policy of the United
9 States; and

10 (2) the Under Secretary for Political Affairs,
11 acting through the Assistant Secretary for European
12 and Eurasian Affairs, should diplomatically engage
13 governments of countries of apparent concern on ef-
14 forts for transatlantic cooperation to counter and
15 address antisemitism and acts of international ter-
16 rorism that may threaten transatlantic stability, the
17 safety and security of United States citizens, and in-
18 stitutions abroad.

1 (b) BRIEFING.—Not later than 180 days after the
2 date of the enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter
3 for two years, the Assistant Secretary for European and
4 Eurasian Affairs shall provide a briefing to the appro-
5 priate congressional committees on the matters described
6 in this section.
