1	SEC OFFICE OF THE SECURITY COORDINATOR.
2	(a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is authorized to be an
3	Office of the Security Coordinator, which shall be an office
4	within the United States Embassy to Israel and shall oper-
5	ate under the authority of the Chief of Mission.
6	(b) REPORTING STRUCTURE.—The United States Se-
7	curity Coordinator (USSC) shall report directly to the
8	United States Ambassador to Israel and shall operate at
9	the direction of the Ambassador, consistent with Chief of
10	Mission authority under section 207 of the Foreign Serv-
11	ice Act of 1980 (Public Law 96–465; 22 U.S.C. 3927)
12	and other applicable provisions of law.
13	(c) Mission.—The mission of the Office of the Secu-
14	rity Coordinator shall be to advance United States na-
15	tional security interests and regional stability by facili-
16	tating coordination and cooperation in mutual security
17	matters between Palestinian security forces and the Gov-
18	ernment of Israel.
19	(d) Policy Alignment.—No activity or engagement
20	undertaken by the Office of the Security Coordinator shall

- 4 (e) Personnel and Support.—The Secretary of
