At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1	SEC PROHIBITION ON SALE AND LICENSING OF
2	MAJOR DEFENSE EQUIPMENT.
3	(a) In General.—No sale, export, or transfer of
4	major defense equipment (as such term is defined in sec-
5	tion 47(6) of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.
6	2794(6)) may be provided to any country the President
7	identifies as supporting the Rapid Support Forces or the
8	Sudanese armed forces through the provision of materiel
9	or other resources or equipment.
10	(b) WAIVER.—The President may waive the prohibi-
11	tion under subsection (a) on a case-by-case basis if the
12	President—
13	(1) determines such a waiver is vital to the na-
14	tional interests of the United States; and
15	(2) not more than 15 days after issuing the
16	waiver, submits to the appropriate congressional
17	committees a notification of the waiver and a de-
18	tailed description and justification for the use of the
19	waiver.

1	(c) Appropriate Congressional Committees De-
2	FINED.—In this section, the term "appropriate congres-
3	sional committees" means—
4	(1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
5	Committee on Appropriations of the House of Rep-
5	resentatives; and
7	(2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and
8	the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate.
