

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5300
OFFERED BY MS. TITUS OF NEVADA

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . REPORT ON DEPLOYMENT OF RUSSIAN S-400 SYS-**
2 **TEM BY TURKEY.**

3 (a) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit
5 to the appropriate congressional committees a report that
6 includes the following:

7 (1) An assessment of the impact of sanctions
8 imposed with respect to the Presidency of Defense
9 Industries of the Republic of Turkey, and with re-
10 spect to any person associated with such Presidency,
11 pursuant to section 231 of the Countering America’s
12 Adversaries Through Sanctions Act (22 U.S.C.
13 9525).

14 (2) A list of nationals of Turkey and contrac-
15 tors of the Government of Turkey operating in the
16 intelligence sector of the Russian Federation, the de-
17 fense sector of the Russian Federation, or a mate-
18 rials sector related to such defense sector.

1 (3) An analysis of the deployment of S-400 air
2 defense systems procured by the Turkish armed
3 forces from the Russian Federation.

4 (4) An assessment of the threat such deploy-
5 ment poses to the national security of the United
6 States.

7 (5) An assessment of the ability of the air force
8 of Turkey to remain interoperable with the air forces
9 and air defense forces of other members of the
10 North Atlantic Treaty Organization, including inter-
11 operability with F-35 aircraft and other advanced
12 systems.

13 (b) FORM OF REPORT.—The report required by sub-
14 section (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form and
15 may contain a classified annex.

16 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
17 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
18 sional committees” means—

19 (1) the Committee on Armed Services, the
20 Committee on Financial Services, and the Com-
21 mittee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-
22 resentatives; and

23 (2) the Committee on Armed Services, the
24 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Af-

1 fairs, and the Committee on Foreign Relations of
2 the Senate.
