

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 9086

OFFERED BY MR. OLSZEWSKI OF MARYLAND

Page 51, after line 6, insert the following (and re-designate accordingly):

1 (f) INTERNATIONAL LABOR AND ECONOMIC POLICY
2 TRAINING.—Section 708 (22 U.S.C. 4028), as amended
3 by this section, is further amended by adding at the end
4 the following:

5 “(j) INTERNATIONAL LABOR AND ECONOMIC POLICY
6 TRAINING.—The Secretary, with the assistance of other
7 relevant officials and the private sector, shall provide ses-
8 sions on—

9 “(1) international labor standards and workers’
10 rights, including the core conventions of the Inter-
11 national Labour Organization;

12 “(2) the relationship between workers’ rights,
13 labor conditions, and international trade and invest-
14 ment; and

15 “(3) economic development frameworks, includ-
16 ing the role of labor market conditions and supply
17 chain due diligence in host country development.”.
