

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 9087
OFFERED BY MR. SMITH OF NEW JERSEY**

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. 6. WALTER PATTERSON JUSTICE AND EXPANDED EX-**
2 **TRADITION REPORT.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 270 days after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act and not later than the
5 end of each 12-month period thereafter for the following
6 four years, the President shall submit to the appropriate
7 congressional committees a report on the following:

8 (1) The number of fugitives, including George
9 Wright who was convicted of murdering Walter Pat-
10 terson, and others with respect to whom the United
11 States Government is seeking extradition or ren-
12 dition, currently residing in other countries whose
13 extradition is sought by the United States and a list
14 of such countries.

15 (2) Diplomatic and other efforts, if any, the
16 United States has undertaken to secure the return
17 of such fugitives.

18 (3) The average length of time these cases have
19 been outstanding.

1 (4) How many of these cases have been resolved
2 to the satisfaction of the United States.

3 (5) Factors that have been barriers to the reso-
4 lution of these cases.

5 (6) Information on the number of United States
6 citizens whose extradition has been sought by other
7 countries during the past five years, a list of such
8 countries, and the outcomes of those requests,

9 (b) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
10 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include
11 a classified annex if determined necessary.

12 (c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “appro-
13 priate congressional committees” means—

14 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the
15 Committee on the Judiciary of the House of Rep-
16 resentatives; and

17 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and
18 the Committee on the Judiciary of the Senate.
