

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 9087
OFFERED BY MS. TITUS OF NEVADA**

At the appropriate place, insert the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . REPORT ON UNFUNDED PRIORITIES OF THE DE-**
2 **PARTMENT OF STATE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 10 days after the
4 date on which the budget for any fiscal year is submitted
5 by the President to Congress pursuant to section 1105 of
6 title 31, United States Code, the Secretary of State shall
7 prepare and submit to the appropriate committees of Con-
8 gress a report on unfunded priorities of the Department
9 of State.

10 (b) ELEMENTS.—

11 (1) IN GENERAL.—The report required by sub-
12 section (a) shall include, with respect to each un-
13 funded priority covered by such report—

14 (A) a summary description of such pri-
15 ority, including the objectives to be achieved if
16 such priority is funded (whether in whole or in
17 part);

1 (B) the additional amount of funds rec-
2 ommended to be made available to achieve the
3 objectives referred to in subparagraph (A); and

4 (C) budget information with respect to
5 such priority, including—

6 (i) the appropriation account;

7 (ii) the expenditure center; and

8 (iii) the project and, if applicable, any
9 subprojects.

10 (2) PRIORITIZATION.—The report required by
11 subsection (a) shall present the unfunded priorities
12 covered by such report in overall order of urgency of
13 priority among unfunded priorities.

14 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

15 (1) the term “appropriate committees of Con-
16 gress” means—

17 (A) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and
18 the Committee on Appropriations of the House
19 of Representatives; and

20 (B) the Committee on Foreign Relations
21 and the Committee on Appropriations of the
22 Senate; and

23 (2) the term “unfunded priority”, with respect
24 to a fiscal year, means a program, activity, or mis-

1 sion requirement of an element of the Department
2 of State that—

3 (A) is not funded in the budget for such
4 fiscal year submitted by the President to Con-
5 gress pursuant to section 1105 of title 31,
6 United States Code;

7 (B) is necessary to fulfill a foreign policy
8 or national security objective or to satisfy an in-
9 formation requirement associated with a goal or
10 objective outlined in the Joint Strategic Plan
11 agreed upon by the Department of State; and

12 (C) would have been recommended for
13 funding by the Secretary of State if—

14 (i) additional resources had been
15 available for such budget to fund such pro-
16 gram, activity, or mission requirement; or

17 (ii) the program, activity, or mission
18 requirement has emerged since such budg-
19 et was formulated.
