## 7/6/16 Subcommittee on Asia and the Pacific Markup Summary

The Chair obtained unanimous consent to consider four measures and three amendments (previously provided to Members of the Subcommittee) *en bloc*:

- 1) <u>H. Res. 210 (Duffy)</u>, "Affirming and recognizing the Khmer, Laotian, Hmong, and Montagnard Freedom Fighters and the people of Cambodia and Laos for their support and defense of the United States Armed Forces and freedom in Southeast Asia."
  - a. Salmon 148, an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H. Res. 210
- 2) <u>H. Res. 634 (Salmon)</u>, "Recognizing the importance of the United States-Republic of Korea-Japan trilateral relationship to counter North Korean threats and nuclear proliferation, and to ensure regional security and human rights."
  - a. Salmon 146, an amendment in the nature of a substitute to H. Res. 634
- 3) <u>H. Res. 728 (Lowenthal)</u>, "Supporting human rights, democracy, and the rule of law in Cambodia."
  - a. Sherman 42
- 4) H.R. 4501 (Salmon), "Distribution and Promotion of Rights and Knowledge Act of 2016."

The items considered *en bloc* were agreed to by voice vote. H. Res. 210, H. Res. 634, H. Res. 728, and H.R. 4501, as amended, were ordered favorably reported to the Full Committee by unanimous consent.
