Alexandre Dayant is a Research Fellow in the Pacific Islands Program at the international policy think tank, the Lowy Institute. His research focuses on all aspects of the Pacific, with a particular interest in development finance, economic governance, economic growth, trade and investment policy, and geoeconomics.

He joined the Institute in 2017 to develop the Pacific Aid Map, which is an annual data-driven assessment that tracks and analyses foreign aid flows to the Pacific.

Prior to the Lowy Institute, Alexandre worked as a management consultant for PwC in Mexico. He has a master's degree in International and Development Economics from the Australian National University and a master's degree in Econometrics from the Sorbonne.
