Ms. Bocklage previously served as the Deputy Director of the Office of Multilateral Nuclear and Security Affairs, June 2020-June 2022 and the Deputy Permanent Representative and Chargé d'Affaires at the U.S. Mission to the Association of Southeast Asian Nations, July 2016 - June 2019. She joined the U.S.

Department of State in 2001 and has served in Bolivia, Vietnam, Macedonia, Vienna, and the Bureau of Political-Military Affairs in Washington, DC. Prior to her diplomatic service, Ms. Bocklage worked as a Foreign Affairs Specialist for the U.S. Army Space and Missile Defense Command and as an arms control analyst for private industry.

As a Marshall Scholar, Ms. Bocklage earned Masters degrees from King's College London and the London School of Economics and Political Science. She is also a Distinguished Graduate of the National War College. Ms. Bocklage also holds a Bachelor's degree from the University of Denver. Ms. Bocklage has received multiple honor awards and was the recipient of the 2009 Secretary's Award for Excellence in International Security Affairs.
