Jenny Jun is a Research Fellow in the CyberAI project at the Center for Security and Emerging Technology (CSET) and Ph.D. Candidate in the Department of Political Science at Columbia University. Her current research explores the dynamics of how coercion works in cyberspace and how AI will shape offensive and defensive cyber operations. Jenny is a co-author of the 2015 Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) report *North Korea's Cyber Operations: Strategy and Responses*. She has presented her work on North Korea's cyber operations at various conferences and has provided government briefings and media interviews on the topic. She received her M.A. and B.S. each from the Security Studies Program (SSP) and the School of Foreign Service (SFS) at Georgetown University.
