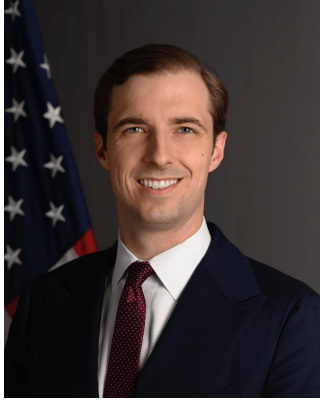




Caleb Orr

Caleb Orr is the Assistant Secretary of State for Economic, Energy, and Business Affairs (EEB), where he helps advance American economic strength, energy dominance, and business leadership on the world stage.

As the head of EEB, Mr. Orr spearheads a robust portfolio spanning international trade, finance, and investment, transportation and associated infrastructure, energy security, critical minerals, sanctions policy, and commercial advocacy. He implements the administration's strategy to reindustrialize the American economy, secure critical supply chains, and unleash U.S. energy production as pillars of national power.

Mr. Orr also coordinates the Department's economic engagement with Venezuela, supporting Secretary Rubio's three-phased approach focused on stabilization, recovery, and transition with targeted sanctions relief and new investment by leading energy, minerals, and financial services firms. Mr. Orr also organized the Department's first-ever Critical Minerals Ministerial, at which Secretary Rubio and representatives from 54 nations and the European Union announced \$30 billion in investment interest, loans, and project financing to build resilient, secure, and independent critical minerals supply chains.

Also under his leadership, the bureau established the Commercial Diplomacy Enterprise (CDE), a Department-wide initiative to identify, prioritize, and advance economic opportunities that serve significant U.S. strategic interests. This program represents a commitment to putting economic statecraft at the heart of what we do—helping American workers, businesses, and communities thrive while securing the supply chains and strategic interests our nation depends on.

A longtime aide to Secretary Rubio, Mr. Orr was previously Senior Policy Advisor to then-Senator Rubio and Deputy Staff Director of the Senate Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship. Mr. Orr also practiced securities and administrative law at Boyden Gray PLLC, the law firm of the late Ambassador C. Boyden Gray.

A proud Texas native, Mr. Orr clerked for Chief Judge Jennifer Walker Elrod of the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit, receiving his J.D. from the Georgetown University Law Center and B.A. from Abilene Christian University.
