She is the Founder and CEO of One By One an international non-profit organization fighting exploitation in some of the world's most impoverished areas. Becky started her career as a pediatric nurse in the United Kingdom after graduating from Sheffield University with Bachelors degree in nursing studies. In 2006, while visiting Sierra Leone, Murray purchased a pair of shoes for a young girl. Becky was disconcerted to learn the child concluded that this action was one intended in exchange for sex. From the weight of this encounter and by the strength of Becky, One By One was established.

One By One is a charitable organization registered in both the UK and the US for impoverished and suffering children. Since being founded in 2011, One By One has provided necessary restorative care, educational support, and empowerment towards sustainable living to prevent exploitation of vulnerable communities across the Third World. Under Becky's leadership, One By One has grown to more than 80 staff members, made up of social workers, teachers, outreach teams, house parents, cooks, cleaners and administrative support. They are have offices in Kenya, Pakistan, Uganda, England and America, while always working to expand the reach of their mission.

Becky is also the founder of the Dignity Project a human trafficking prevention program which has reached more than 30,000 girls in eight countries. She is an author and hosts a television series on TBN UK. Becky has spoken at 10 Downing Street and has appeared on the BBC and many other media outlets.

Becky is married to Matthew and the couple have one son, Josiah, who was born in 2011. The Murrays reside in South Yorkshire, England.
