Paulo Figueiredo, grandson of former Brazilian President João Figueiredo, is a journalist.

He holds a specialization in Entrepreneurship and Innovation from Harvard Business School, certifications in Business, International Relations, and Political Economy from the London School of Economics, and a MicroMasters in Microeconomics from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).

As a journalist, Figueiredo stands out as one of the most courageous voices in the Brazilian media, having been the absolute leader in audience ratings for various television programs on the JP News network. On his social media accounts and YouTube channel, he has millions of subscribers seeking a perspective absent from the legacy media. He currently hosts the Paulo Figueiredo Show, which leads the audience ratings in its time slot on the internet.

In 2022, the Supreme Federal Court of Brazil decided to block all of his social media accounts in Brazil, freeze all of his financial assets, and cancel his passport – without any communication or accusation. Since then, he has been working tirelessly to denounce the Brazilian dictatorship abroad.

In the United States, he has been interviewed and participated in various programs, including with Tucker Carlson, PragerU, Steven Crowder, Dinesh D'Souza, Dave Rubin, and Patrick Bet-David, in addition to multiple appearances commenting on Latin American affairs on television networks and podcasts
