

Dr. Aaron Padilla, *Senior Advisor, International Policy*, American Petroleum Institute

Aaron is Senior Advisor for International Policy at the American Petroleum Institute (API). Aaron leads API's work on key international issues, especially trade and global economic policy. Aaron also leads API's sustainability work on the issues of environmental/social/governance (ESG) reporting, revenue transparency (including the Extractive Industries Transparency Initiative – EITI) and the industry's relationship to non-governmental organizations on climate change. Aaron also leads API's work on cybersecurity.

Prior to joining API, Aaron worked for Chevron as Senior Advisor for Global Issues & Public Policy, with responsibilities for both asset-level support for sustainability performance and representing the company globally for key sustainability policy initiatives. Before Chevron, Aaron worked for the environmental consulting firm ERM.

Dr. Padilla is a Marshall Scholar and Truman Scholar, and he completed his M.Phil. and Ph.D. at the University of Cambridge. He holds a B.A. from Stanford University, where he studied as a Coca-Cola Scholar and graduated Phi Beta Kappa.
