In that capacity, she was the lead Republican staffer in the U.S. House of Representatives on U.S. policy towards Latin America and the Caribbean and also managed the congressman's equities before the Committee on Homeland Security and the U.S.-Mexico Interparliamentary Group.

(U) Before serving in Congress, she led the Latin America portfolio at The Heritage Foundation for seven years and started her career in DC at the Defense Intelligence Agency.
