

Though it does not involve me, The Washington Institute has an Intergovernmental Personnel Act (IPA) Agreement with the Department of State enabling an employee to work in the Department of State's Office of the Special Envoy for Israeli-Palestinian Negotiations. The agreement is from 11/7/2013 to 11/16/2014 and is for \$288,000.
