

Jared Genser is managing director of Perseus Strategies, a public interest law firm, and adjunct professor of law at Georgetown University Law Center. Genser is renowned in his field for his work freeing political prisoners, and has been referred to as “The Extractor” by the *New York Times* for his success in this field. He is a recipient of the American Bar Association’s International Human Rights Award. His pro bono clients have included former Czech Republic President Václav Havel and Nobel Peace Prize Laureates Aung San Suu Kyi, Liu Xiaobo, Desmond Tutu, and Elie Wiesel.
