

Mrs. Christine Levinson

Christine Levinson is the wife of Robert Levinson. On March 9, 2007, Mr. Levinson, a former D.E.A. and F.B.I. agent and C.I.A. contractor, disappeared in Kish Island, Iran. The Iranian government has repeatedly denied that Mr. Levinson is in Iranian custody, despite his family's and the United States government's repeated requests for information on his whereabouts. Mrs. Levinson continues to advocate for her husband's release, as she has done for the last 12 years. She has visited Iran and has met with Iranian and U.S. government officials. Mrs. Levinson and her family filed a lawsuit against Iran in May 2017—10 years after Mr. Levinson's disappearance—for hostage-taking and mistreatment.

Mr. and Mrs. Levinson have seven children and six grandchildren.
