Dr. Wendin D. Smith is currently a Managing Director at Deloitte Consulting. Prior to Deloitte, Dr. Smith served as the Senior Advisor to the U.S. Special Operations Command (USSOCOM) for Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction (CWMD), and as the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (DASD) for CWMD in the Office of the Secretary of Defense, Policy.

Previously, Dr. Smith supported public and private sector clients, including the U.S. Departments of Defense and Energy, in designing and executing cooperative threat reduction, nonproliferation, and public diplomacy programs in

the former Soviet Union.
