Mr. Hardin Lang is vice president for programs and policy at Refugees International. He has served in a number of United Nations peacekeeping and humanitarian field missions, including in Afghanistan, the Balkans, Central America, Iraq, and West Africa. He served as head of office for the UN special envoy for the Haiti after the 2010 earthquake and as an adviser to the UN special representative in Baghdad.

Prior to joining Refugees International, Mr. Lang was a senior fellow at the Center for American Progress (CAP) and at the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS). He has published widely, including in Axios, the Wall Street Journal, Foreign Policy, Newsweek, and U.S. News and World Report.
