Hardin Lang is vice president for programs and policy at Refugees International. He has reported extensively on the humanitarian situation in Syria and the refugee crisis in neighboring countries. During his UN tenure, Hardin worked as head of office for President Clinton in his role as UN special envoy for Haiti. He helped launch the UN stabilization mission in Mali and served as an adviser to the UN special representative in Iraq. Hardin also deployed with UN peacekeeping and stabilization missions in Kosovo and Guatemala.

Hardin has also been a senior fellow at the Center for American Progress (CAP) and the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS). He has published widely with over 70 author credits, including in *Axios, Just Security, Wall Street Journal, The Hill, Foreign Policy, Newsweek,* and *U.S. News & World Report.* Hardin holds master's degrees Princeton University and the London School of Economics, and a bachelor's degree from Oberlin College.
