

David A. Merkel is Senior Fellow at the Atlantic Council, Managing Director of Summit International Advisors, and at the Azerbaijan Diplomatic Academy a Visiting Faculty Member in the Geopolitics of Energy.

Mr. Merkel has served as Deputy Assistant Secretary for European and Eurasian Affairs at the U.S. Department of State, in the White House he served as Director for European and Eurasian Affairs and later as Director for South and Central Asian Affairs on the National Security Council. Previously, Mr Merkel was Deputy Assistant Secretary for International Affairs at the U.S. Treasury Department; International Counselor to the Chairman of the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC). and Senior Professional Staff on the Senate Foreign Relations Committee.

He is currently a member of the Board of Trustees of Nazarbayev University in Astana, Kazakhstan, the Josef Korbel School of International Studies Social Science Foundation at the University of Denver and American University School of International Studies Dean's Council in Washington, D.C.
